An English course at the minimum grade 12 level¹ (Canadian or equivalent) 3. A Math OR Statistics course at the minimum grade 12 level (Canadian or equivalent) 	<p>Submit a copy of transcripts from all secondary and post-secondary institutions attended. If post-secondary transcripts show all required academic prerequisites, the secondary transcript is not required.</p> <p>Only education completed within Canada, or its equivalent, will be considered. If you completed your education outside of Canada, you must verify and validate the education through services such as the World Education Services.</p> <p>¹Applicants who do not have a minimum of Canadian grade 12 English must show proof of English proficiency. Please review the Language Requirements drop-down on the website for a list of accepted English proficiency tests/scores.</p>

In this case, the applicant must use the PLAR application (see Prior Learning Assessment drop-down on the website).</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Recommendation Letters (2)</p>	<p>Two (2) professional or academic letters of recommendation which attest to your suitability to study in the HIM Program, and evidence that you are a good fit to work in the field of HIM.</p>	<p>Proof of employment does not satisfy this component. These letters must be written by someone who has supervised or evaluated you in a professional or academic setting. Personal references will not be accepted.</p>

<input type="checkbox"/>	Practicum Site Confirmation	<p>Documentation is no longer required for admission, but it is strongly recommended that students secure an on-site practicum prior to their first term in the regular HIM curriculum (after completion of the biomedical sciences).</p> <p>Alternative projects will be available for those unable to secure a site (fees and restrictions apply).</p>	<p>If you live in Alberta, please refer to the two added requirements referred to below.</p> <p>You will be asked to identify if you intend to complete practicums from a list of jurisdictions or health organizations as they have specific requirements to be completed prior to practicums. If applicable, more information will be provided or requested of you at a later date.</p>
<p>Important: All successful applicants will be required to submit vaccination requirements and a police record check upon admission. These documents are a requirement for practicum placements. More information will be provided upon acceptance. Please do not acquire records and/or updated immunizations prior to acceptance. Instructions will be sent from CHA Learning. There may be a charge for criminal record checks, and this is the responsibility of the student.</p>
